
Appeals - Complaint Procedure: Due Process


This chart is to help students with the necessary information about fair treatment for each student involved in a grievance (problem), discrimination complaint, or a discipline action not involving suspension or expulsion

SCHOOL-LEVEL DECISION


Please note- the chart indicates an appeal to the principal. If the issue is with a teacher or other staff, the appeal should start directly with the teacher and work up the heirarchy (teacher-resourse teacher/department chairman-principal)

- 1. A request for a review of the complaint and the decision of the principal
- 2. All pertinent factual information
- 3. The remedy requested
