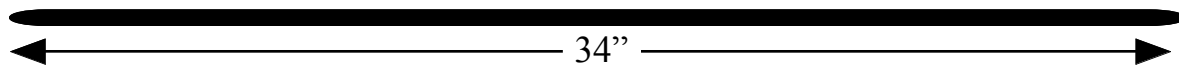
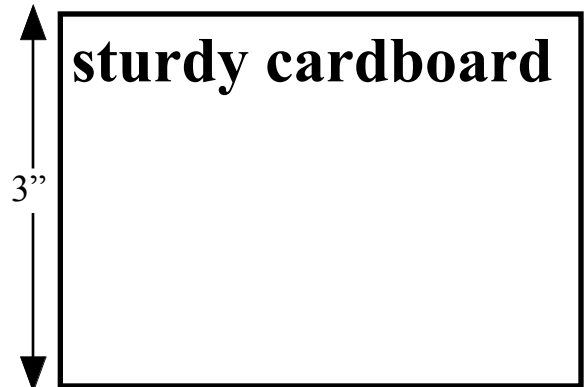


How to make "Friendly Fringees"

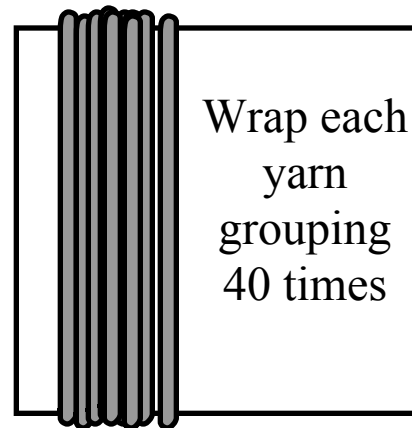
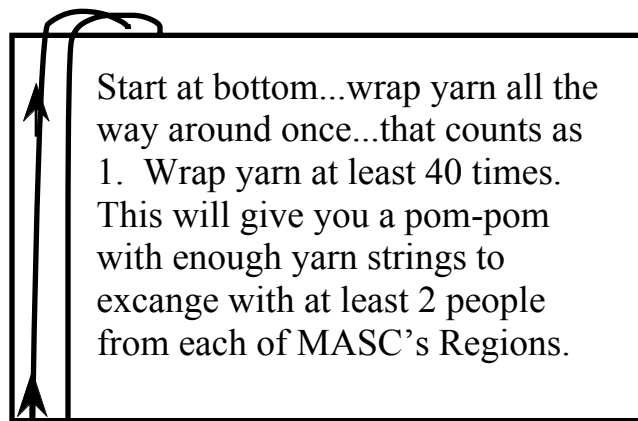
1. Precut lengths of yarn approximately 34" to go around the neck...cut one for each of your delegates and advisors, and one or two extra.



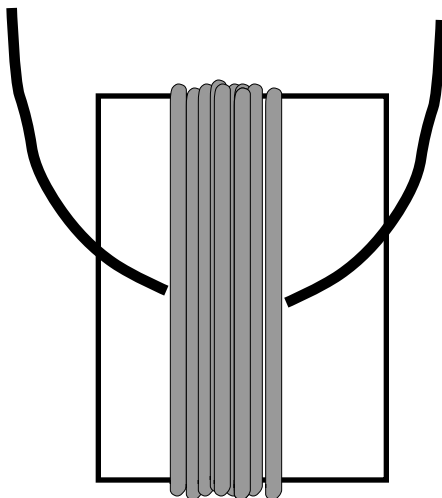
2. Cut heavy cardboard 3" high (so all pom-poms are a consistent size). If you wish, make it wide enough so that you can make several pom-poms at one time.



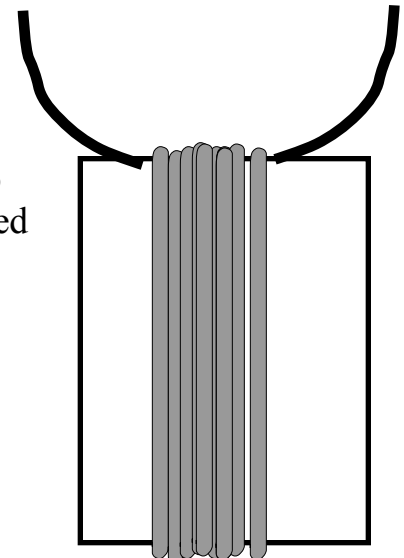
3. Start at bottom...wrap yarn all the way around once...that counts as 1. Wrap yarn at least 40 times. This will give you a pom-pom with enough yarn strings to exchange with at least 2 people from each of MASC's Regions.



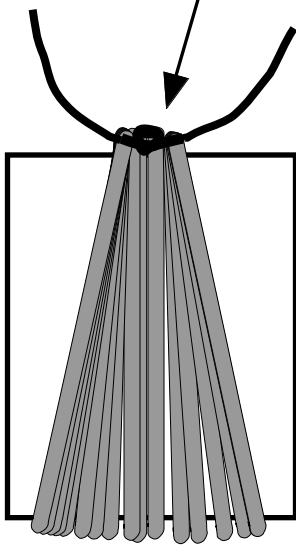
4. Take one precut neck yarn length and put it behind the wrapped yarn.



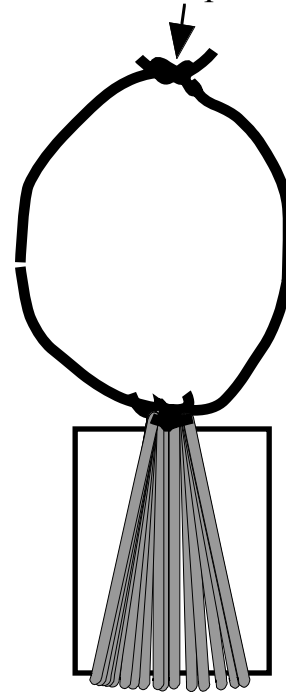
5. Pull the neck yarn to the top of the wrapped yarn.



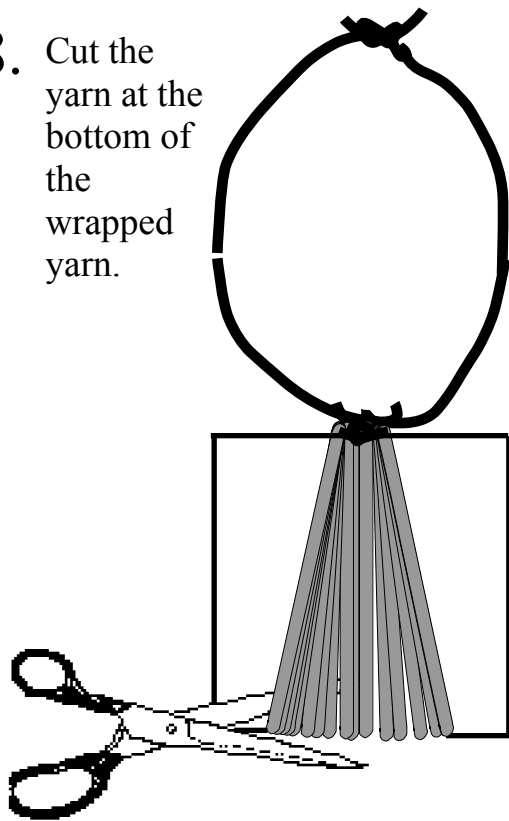
6. Tie a secure knot around the top of the wrapped yarn



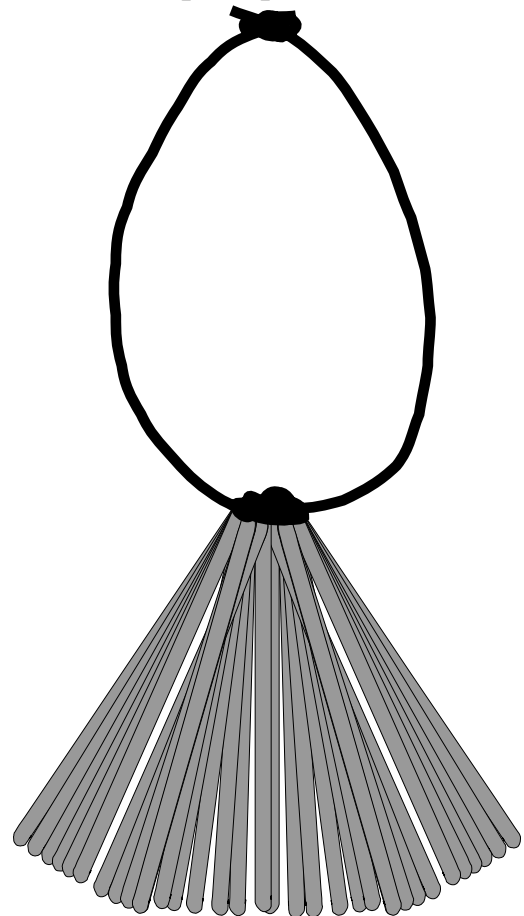
7. Tie a secure knot at the top of the neck yarn.



8. Cut the yarn at the bottom of the wrapped yarn.



9. "Fluff" out the pom-pom.



The yield is 1 Friendly Fringe.
