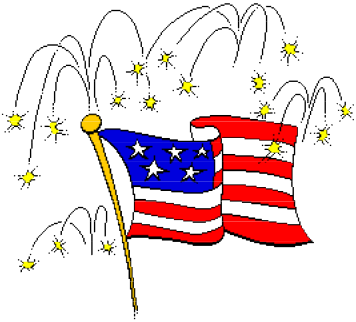


SGA ELECTIONS

There are four major things that you must do:

1. First, **DISCUSS** the responsibilities with your parents. Are you willing to put in the necessary time for this year? Can you manage the extra workload and still keep up your grades? Why do you really want to be an officer in the SGA? Be sure to **return your parent letter** by _____.
2. Complete and turn in the **PROFILE SHEET** by _____.
3. Start your **CAMPAIGN**.... You may want to make posters, buttons, flyers, banners, etc. (You must provide your own materials, including tape.) **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE APPROPRIATENESS OF ALL OF YOUR CAMPAIGN MATERIALS.** Campaign materials can be put up in the cafeteria or your team hall. It is your responsibility to read and abide by all campaign rules (see attached).
4. Ask an adult in the building to sponsor you. Your sponsor must proof read your posters, literature, etc. and sign their name in a corner **BEFORE** you put up materials. **YOU ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR TAKING DOWN MATERIALS AT THE END OF THE CAMPAIGN PERIOD.**
5. Begin to prepare your speech. Read all of the helpful hints, type your script, and be ready by the approval deadline of _____.
