

# BASIC REQUIREMENTS

## SGA Executive Cabinet

Two Students (one male & one female) from each Team will be elected from the Team At Large to represent their Team and serve a term of one year on the  
**Executive Cabinet.**



### Basic requirements:

- must maintain a 2.0 grade point average with no more than one E (county requirements) - must have demonstrated and maintain exemplary behavior and academic ethics.
- must be willing to chair an after school "ad hoc" committee as needed
- must meet with and report to Team Representatives all necessary information concerning activities and issues as discussed at Executive Cabinet meetings
- must be willing to meet after school at least once a month for Executive Cabinet meetings, meet once a month during TAP for Executive Cabinet meetings, and participate once a month during school in the General Assembly meeting
- must be willing to preside once a month during TAP at the grade level House of Representative meeting
- must be willing to plan and participate with your Team IRT (adult leader) for a Team Town Meeting
- must be able to check daily with the SGA advisor

### Basic requirements:

- must maintain a 2.0 grade point average with no more than one E (county requirements) - must have demonstrated and maintain exemplary behavior and academic ethics.
- must be willing to serve on one after school "ad hoc" committee as needed
- must be willing to meet once a month during school for a General Assembly and once a month during activity period or lunch for a grade level House of Representatives meeting
- must be willing to lead discussions in homeroom class and report to homeroom after General Assembly meetings and House of Representatives meetings
- must be willing to listen and report on students' concerns
- must be able to check daily the SGA bulletin board
