Contact your local Muscular Dystrophy Association ([www.mdaua.org](http://www.mdaua.org)) to get the shamrocks and all of the information (you could also make your own paper shamrocks with a die-cutting machine)...

Pick the week you want to sell. Assign jobs for each person in the committee (design and hang up posters, assign sellers, write PA announcements, etc.)

Decide the type of competition (if desired) - between homerooms, class, boys and girls, etc.)

Make tally sheets for each day to mark each sale and the homeroom in which the person who bought the shamrock is in

Decide on a prize

Contact people involved with the prize (business, teachers, etc. - depends on what your prize is).

Sell shamrocks for \$1.00 each day at lunch

Hang up the shamrocks in school after each days' sales

Send a thank you to whomever helped out with the sales and prizes

After a certain period of time, take the displayed shamrocks down.
