

Human Machine

There are two ways to make a human machine (and variations you may invent!)

- Divide into groups of eight to ten people. Explain that the group must make a human machine. Each person in the group will be a part in the machine. He/she must be connected to another moving part of the machine, must make some type of movement (ie: bending an arm, squatting and standing, etc.) and must make some type of noise to go along with his/her movement. (Optional - the machine should serve a function.) Have groups share their invention.
- This machine is basically the same as above, however, one member of the group should start the machine with a movement and sound and then, one at a time, each person connects him/herself to another part, making a new movement and a new sound. Continue until all are in the machine. Try to figure out what to call your new invention - share with the other groups.

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
