

DIRECTIONS and PARKING: ANNAPOLIS, MARYLAND...

When the state legislature is meeting, Annapolis is the hardest place to find parking. The directions below will take you to a parking lot from which you can take a shuttle downtown. PLEASE follow these directions! You will not be able to find parking in garages or on the street in Annapolis. Furthermore, parking downtown is more expensive than parking at the stadium and taking the shuttle. Directions to the Navy/Marine Corps Stadium:

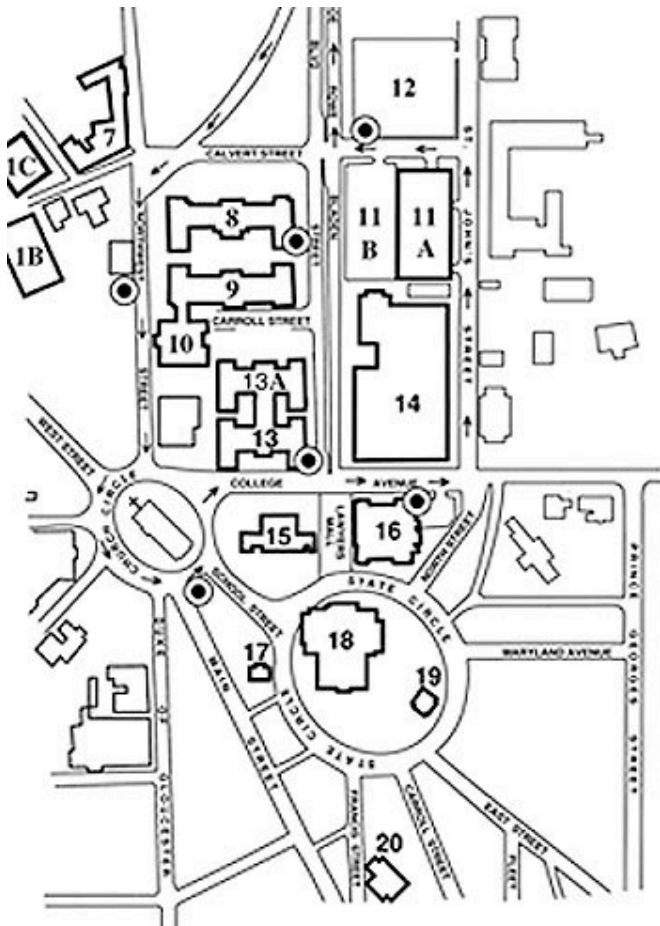
- Take Route 50 toward Annapolis to exit 24-Route 70/Rowe Blvd/Annapolis.
- Stay to the right on the exit ramp and go to the right at the bottom of the ramp.
- At the second light, turn right onto Taylor Avenue (pass the stadium on your right before you turn).
- Take the second or third right, where you see a sign that says "Public or Shuttle Bus Parking"
- Go up the hill. Pay the person in the little white house \$5.00. Park on the left as soon as possible.
 - *The parking pass for the driver gives a free ride on the Trolley*
 - *Trolley Shuttle Bus – \$2.00 one way - Runs from Stadium Parking Lot to downtown Annapolis*
 - *Mon.-Fri., 6:30 a.m.-7:00 p.m., every 20 minutes (more frequently at rush hour)*
 - *Saturday & Sunday, 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.*
 - *Trolley runs until 10:00 p.m. on Monday evenings (when there are general assemblies). No service on State holidays.*

Once you have parked... From here, you will catch the trolley into downtown. The trolley stop is on your right when you enter the parking lot. The trolley comes every 20 minutes. Get on the trolley – pay for ticket pass. You will pass stops at the Department of Natural Resources, Circuit Court House, Church Circle, etc. Get off at the Legislative Services Building stop. Across the street are the Miller Senate Office Building and the Lowe House Office Building.

You will need your driver's license or photo ID to get through security at all of these buildings.

When you leave, you will catch the trolley at the Legislative Services building back to the Navy Stadium and to your car.
