Join the MASC delegation **November 15-17, 2019, for the Leadership Experience and Development (LEAD) Conference at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City, in Arlington, VA** (located just minutes away from our nation's capital and metro)!

**Be a part of the MASC delegation to the LEAD conference November 15-17, 2019.**

MASC has reserved 20 rooms. Students are assigned four per room. We have limited space, so check that your school is a NatStuCo or NHS/NJHS member school. *Registration of \$215 is based on rates for those schools that have a current NatStuCo, NHS or NJHS membership PLUS the early bird special! This amount will be paid directly to NASSP when schools or students register. The non-member early bird rate is \$340.*

**Early bird LEAD registration deadline is September 27, 2019!**  
*The price after that, until the deadline, is \$235 for members and \$360 for non-members*  
**The registration fee is paid directly by the student or school to NASSP.**

*Schools bringing a large delegation need to have an advisor from their school or region. If a school would like to use rooms already reserved by MASC, please check with Karen Crawford ahead of time for availability.*

**Student Estimated Costs (Based on 4 students per room – room costs may be more if a room is not full)**

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you are a student attending under MASC (not your school), you will be expected to register with NatStuCo on-line (MASC will give you the group number) and you will need to pay the registration fee directly to NASSP with a credit card or mail a check. Once you register, you **MUST** pay or find a substitute as NASSP will not refund money once you register. In addition, after September 27th, if you have sent a commitment form to MASC to attend, you will be responsible for the hotel cost - if you drop out, you must find a substitute (same gender) or pay the hotel fee.

Hotel room, per night @ \$140.00 + \$13.25 taxes (\$158.55) x 2 nights / 4 students per room	\$79.28 *
Fri/Sat fast food dinner & Saturday site seeing (Metro card) – students bring cash for these items	\$40.00
Chaperone Fee (for students not attending with their school advisor but under the MASC executive director)	\$25.00
<b>Total estimated cost per student based on four students per room</b>	<b>\$359.28</b>
<b>Advisor total cost based on two per adults per room</b>	<b>\$413.55</b>

\* If a room does not have four students per room, the room cost will go up – MASC cannot guarantee filling each room with four students per room **TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE HOTEL IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT.**

**COMMITMENT FORM FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING UNDER MASC:** I agree to the student-estimated costs listed above (a detailed invoice will be emailed). I will be responsible for all payments or will find a substitute (same gender) if I drop out. I understand that the registration fee is paid directly to NASSP (not MASC) and the invoice for the hotel/chaperone fee will be paid to MASC no later than November 15, 2019.
