



Region 2 Adult and Student Liaison 2020-2021

Application Information

Deadline: December 16, 2019

Thank you for your interest in applying to become the Region 2 Adult or Student Liaison. Region 2 represents Maryland, Delaware, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania. The adult and student liaison rotates each year among the five states. Maryland's rotation will start at the end of April 2020.

Mission Statement: Region 2 strives to positively guide and encourage effective leadership among current and future generations throughout the states of Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania. While acting on this vision, Region 2 will stimulate all student leaders, advisers, and individuals to unite and motivate the growth of Student Councils.

Term of Office: Starting at the end of the April 24-26, 2020 Region 2 conference in New York, through the end of the April 2021 Region 2 Conference in Maryland.

*Qualifications:

- Be a member of a Maryland Association of Student Councils (school or affiliate membership)
 - Be able to attend the April 24-26, 2020 Region 2 Conference
 - Be able to attend the June 2020 National Conference
 - Be able to attend the April 2021 Region 2 Conference
- Adult – have at least three to five years of advising in student leadership*
- Student – be a current sophomore or junior*

**MASC will be able to pay the registration fee for the adult and student representative to the Region 2 Conference in New York (April 2020) and the National Conference in Colorado (June 2020). For state events, the states will waive the registration fee and MASC will pay up to \$100 for travel, food, hotel, etc., for one visit per the four other states.*

The liaisons selected will be expected to:

- Serve as the co-coordinator for the Region 2 activity before the June 22-24, 2020 National Conference in Colorado
- Update and maintain the Region 2 website
- Foster communication between the state presidents and executive directors of Region 2.
- Foster the sharing of ideas and projects among the state organizations of Region 2.
- Represent Region 2 (along with the Student Liaison) at state conferences throughout the region, visiting each state, if possible at least once during the year.
- Present workshops and speak on behalf of the region when visiting the other states (if invited to present)
- Serve as the Co-Chair for the April 2021 Region 2 Conference in Maryland
- *Adult Liaison will also be expected to serve as an advisor to the student liaison and chaperone him/her to conferences/events outside of the state as needed. Most states have Saturday conferences.*

Nomination & Selection Procedures

In the case of multiple candidates, an electronic interview will take place with the state executive director(s), one regional advisor, one regional president and the MASC officers. The selected candidates will be notified by January 5, 2020.

- Contact information (name, email, cell phone, MASC region, school/office, principal/supervisor name, principal/supervisor email)
- Years of student leadership advising
- Letter of interest (*maximum one page*) on why you would like to be the Region 2 adult liaison and why you would be the best candidate.
- Letter of recommendation (*maximum one page*) from a **student** who is a current officer or member in your school's student council or regional organization.
- Letter of recommendation and support (*maximum one page*) from your **principal or supervisor**, indicating his or her support for this application and provision of the necessary release time for you to serve if selected.

- Years of being involved with student leadership
- List the **most** important leadership positions for which you were directly responsible. Positions can be elected or appointed. Note the organization name, where leadership position was performed, and the level of the organizations (local, state or national).
- Letter of interest (*maximum one page*) on why you would like to be the Region 2 student liaison and why you would be the best candidate.
- Letter of support and recommendation (*maximum one page*) from your **student council advisor or regional advisor**
- Letter of support and recommendation (*maximum one page*) from your **principal** indicating his or her support for this application and approval of the necessary release time for you to serve if selected.
