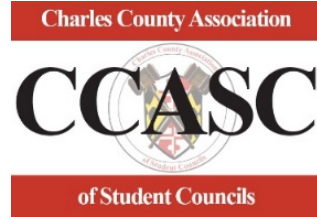

We are proud to announce that Charles County Association of Student Councils (CCASC) is sponsoring a Southern Leadership Conference (SLC) on Saturday, January 18, 2020, from 9:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. (on-site check-in from 9:00-9:30 a.m.). This year's Southern Leadership Conference will be hosted by the Charles County Association of Student Councils (CCASC) and held at the Henry E. Lackey High School. The registration cost for the conference is \$10, which will cover the cost of food, materials, and part of the facilities for the attendees.
