During the meeting, members voted on on five pieces on legislation:

- 1. State SMOB Election Rules
- 2. Legislative Session General Assembly Standing Rules
- 3. MASC Officer Election Rules
- 4. MASC Convention General Assembly Standing Rules
- 5. Selection for State SMOB Nominees

Items 1-4 were approved by a simple majority and Item 5 was tabled for the next Executive Board Meeting.

MASC was thrilled to welcome Christina Alton, the Harford County Mental Health Specalist to the meeting to provide participants with a suicide prevention workshop that focused on the QPR model - Question, Persuade, and Refer. Ms. Alton sees this as a vital tool for mental health first aid designed for anyone (not just professionals) to use. Participants were also provided with the opportunity to attend workshops geared toward planning for upcoming conferences - Legislative Session and Convention.
