Organizations earn an average of \$600! No door-to-door selling is required. Simply collect gently used items from your community (clothing, shoes, books, small household items, CDs/DVDs, etc.) and FUNDrive will pay your nonprofit directly for those items.

How do I get started?

Simply complete the contact information. A FUNDrive representative will be in touch.



What groups can participate in the FUNDrive program? FUNDrive groups must be a nonrofit and/or charitable organization (public schools meet this qualification).

What are the delivery guidelines?

Organizations must provide an accurate bag (clothing) and box (small household items, books, CDs, DVDs, etc.) count and have a prescheduled delivery appointment (date and time). To make delivery more convenient, a rental truck allowance is available for deliveries meeting a minimum volume requirement.

What is accepted during a FUNDrive®? A

representative will provide you with specific opportunities available at your local store drop off location. Typically, however, stores are looking to purchase gently used clothing, books, and household goods.

Is the FUNDrive program available everywhere? FUNDrive is available where most Savers, Value Village, 2nd Ave., or Unique stores are located in the U.S. and Canada – it is not available in Minnesota or Quebec.

Why do we have to sign an agreement and provide a W-9? The agreement is to ensure all the details of the buy/sell relationships are communicated clearly (and for FUNDrive to fulfill their federal end-of-year tax reporting requirements).

When will we receive payment for a FUNDrive.

Payment will be made directly to the nonprofit organization after the delivery and the bag/box count confirmed.



On average, how much does an organization earn?

Most organization earn at least \$600 per FUNDrive.
