For the first time in State Board history, we established legislative principles through our Educational Policy Committee, which I am a member of. We worked hard to ensure that the board has established priorities for the upcoming legislative session.

By the New Year, I will have also completed my visit to the Howard County Association of Student Councils (HCASC) for their session on engaging with legislators.
