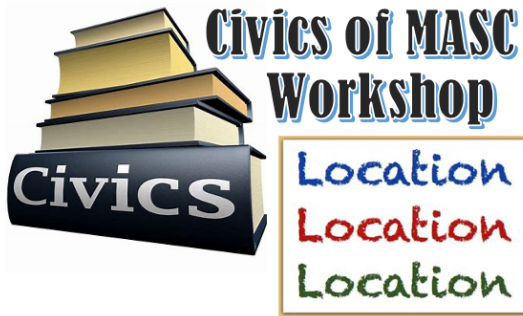




# 2024 MASC Convention
