LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

MASC holds various conferences for students throughout the year where certified student leaders facilitate workshops written by students for students. MASC also participates in initiatives and services pertinent to youth.

STUDENT ADVOCACY

MASC communicates with the Maryland General Assembly as well as various interest groups and the State Board of Education advocating student rights. Importantly, MASC nominates two students, one of whom is appointed by the Governor to serve as a voting member on the State Board of Education. MASC also appoints a voting student member on the Advisory to the Subcabinet, Maryland Center for School Safety.

COMMUNICATION

Student leaders around the state unite under MASC through similar networks on regional levels which communicate to individual middle and high schools. Through this structure, MASC is able to share ideas and gather as a general assembly to take stances on issues.

MEMBERSHIP

MASC is an organization of school student councils, thus membership is only through the school. A school student council advisor or administrator can complete the easy on-line application. Membership voting and fees align with the school's population size. MASC membership opens on August 1st every year.
