



Student Government Association (SGA) or Student Council Levels

1. Bronze Level SGA

- Possesses a basic understanding and representation of student issues
- Plans and engages in school events, activities, and elections
- Maintains regular attendance at SGA meetings and school events, but minimal engagement in advocacy efforts



2. Silver Level SGA



- Represents and advocates for student interests through consistent and effective communication
- Conducts well-organized meetings and events, and ensures fair election processes
- Maintains consistent attendance, engagement, and collaboration with students and other entities

3. Gold Level SGA

- Works with all students to accurately represent the student voice and unite over shared interests of advocacy and civic engagement
- Executes events and meetings with clear objectives to promote student leadership, engagement, and networking
- Ensures fair and transparent election processes and achieves high levels of student involvement and participation
