Dear Student Leaders and Advisors,

The Maryland Association of Student Councils (MASC) invites you to our third major "S.G.Agents" event of the year! This year, students from across Maryland will go undercover to unlock their inner leadership potential at the MASC Convention, taking place Wednesday, March 18, through Friday, March 20, at the Ocean City Convention Center. We're excited to announce that Allegany High School and Braddock Middle School will serve as our official staff hosts!

Throughout this top-secret, three-day mission, delegates will attend classified leadership workshops, hear from a nationally recognized motivational speaker, elect the 2026–2027 MASC officers, and participate in nightly supervised "recreation operations." Agents will gain the skills, confidence, and teamwork abilities necessary to succeed in any leadership mission they undertake back home.

Schools may register an equal number of voting delegates and observers, plus any MASC executive board members. MASC recommends a ratio of one advisor per ten students to ensure each operation runs smoothly. This year's convention involves a three-part registration process:

- 1. Ensure you are an official MASC Member School by clicking <u>HERE</u>. (Membership closes January 1, 2026.)
- 2. Register for the **Convention** through MASC's standard conference registration process advisors only!
- 3. Reserve and pay for hotel rooms. MASC has contracts with partner hotels that have blocked out rooms specifically for this conference.

Early Bird registration runs from December 1 through January 9 and requires payment or a purchase order by February 6 to receive the discounted rate. Regular registration will be open from January 10 through February 6, 2026.

Three meals on Thursday and breakfast on Friday are included in the registration fee, along with evening operation snacks and an exclusive "S.G.Agents" convention t-shirt. The Convention Center concession stand will also be open during evening recreation periods, so agents may want to bring extra money for snacks and MASC merchandise. MASC gear sells out quickly, so we encourage students to preview items online and plan to make their purchases early on Wednesday evening.

One of the highlights of the convention is the networking, where delegates and advisors will exchange information and ideas with hundreds of student leaders and advisors from across the state. We hope you'll accept this mission and join us for this exciting, agent-themed, three-day leadership experience!
