

Legislation Title: Updates to the Officer Position Descriptions in the Maryland Association of Student Councils' Constitution

Whereas, the current elected officer position description within the Constitution of the Maryland Association of Student Councils no longer fully reflects the organization's structure, responsibilities, and internal operations of MASC as a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit; and

Whereas, outdated or ambiguous language has caused inconsistencies in how officer responsibilities are interpreted and carried out across terms; and

Whereas, several officer duties listed under Article IX referenced procedures and or responsibilities that have now been solely vested within the MASC Board of Directors and or MASC's adult coordinators; and

Whereas, the MASC Constitutional Review Committee approved the following amendments on their third meeting on the 21st of September 2025;

Be it hereby resolved, the Maryland Association of Student Councils amends its Constitution as follows:

1. In Article IX, Elected Officers, Section 2(A), "Present to the State Board of Education at least twice a year;" shall be stricken in its entirety; and
2. In Article IX, Elected Officers, Section 2(A), "Serve as the official representative of MASC to the Maryland State Board of Education;"; shall be inserted in its entirety; and
3. In Article IX, Elected Officers, Section 2(D), "and collection of dues" shall be stricken in its entirety; and
4. In Article IX, Elected Officers, Section 2(D), "Work with the Board of Directors Treasurer to", shall be inserted before the previous language of "present an annual budget to the Executive Board;"; and
5. In Article IX, Elected Officers, Section 2(D), "Work with the Adult Awards Coordinator to coordinate all MASC Awards; Present the credentials report before voting takes place in all business meetings;" shall be inserted in its entirety; and

6. All subsequent subsections shall be relettered accordingly.
