

**Legislation Title:** Adjustment of Elected Officer Terms in the Maryland Association of Student Councils' Constitution

**Whereas**, the current transition date for elected officers no longer aligns with the operational needs and meeting schedule of the Maryland Association of Student Councils; and

**Whereas**, updating the term end date to coincide with the May/June Executive Board Meeting will improve continuity, ensure consistent leadership transitions, and strengthen organizational stability; and

**Whereas**, the MASC Constitutional Review Committee approved the amendment on their third meeting on the 19th of October 2025;

**Be it hereby resolved**, the Maryland Association of Student Councils amends its Constitution as follows:

1. In Article X, Qualifications, Elections, and Terms of Office of MASC Officers, Section 3, "The elected officers shall serve their term of office until June 1, following the election of their successors." shall be stricken in its entirety; and
2. In Article X, Qualifications, Elections, and Terms of Office of MASC Officers, Section 3, "The elected officers shall serve their term of office until the May/June Executive Board Meeting, when the new officers are sworn in." shall be inserted in its entirety; and
3. All subsequent subsections shall be relettered accordingly.
